## Call for Applications for the Hyman and Faye Halbert "New Beginnings" Collaboration Track for 2024-2025

The Halbert Centre and the Hyman and Faye Halbert Memorial Fund are pleased to announce the Hyman and Faye Halbert "New Beginnings" collaboration track for the academic year 2024-2025. This new grant aims to initiate and promote scholarly exchanges between faculty members of the Hebrew University of Jerusalem and faculty affiliated with recognized higher education institutions in Canada that have never collaborated on a substantial basis before.

<u>Eligibility</u>: The "New Beginnings" Faculty Collaboration Grant is open to both tenured and non-tenured (with Teken) faculty members in the faculties of humanities, social sciences, social work, education, law and business administration at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. Applications should include at least one collaborator from a higher education institution in Canada.

<u>Grant Coverage:</u> The grant will cover a contribution towards research activities (e.g. hiring research assistants, conducting surveys, purchasing data, professional editing or any acceptable expenses directly related to the research). A total maximum amount of \$5,000 (Canadian Dollars).

<u>Application Deadline:</u> The final date for submission of grant applications is **February 29**, **2024.** 

<u>Review and Decision:</u> The Academic Committee of the Halbert Centre will review the applications and announce its decisions **during the second semester**.

<u>Grant Utilization</u>: The utilization of the grant is valid for a period of 12 months starting in October 2024.

<u>Budget Management:</u> The budget will be managed by the Halbert Centre, according to the details stated in the grant proposal.
